**STATEWIDE INTEROPERABLE AND EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS BOARD
HOLDS MEETING ON SEPTEMBER 18, 2013**

Pursuant to Public Officers Law Section 104, the Office of Interoperable and Emergency Communications gives notice of a meeting of the Statewide Interoperable and Emergency Communications (SIEC) Board, on Wednesday, September 18, 2013, at 10:00 a.m., in Albany, New York.

The SIEC Board was established under Article 26 and 6A of the Executive and County law, respectively, to review policies and programs intended to improve interoperable and emergency communications for first responders throughout the State and make recommendations to the Commissioner of the Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services. The Board will consider guidelines for statewide interoperable communications planning and the development of regionally-based public safety radio communications systems consistent with federal mandates, industry best practices and parameters for the use of resources for this purpose. In addition, the Board is authorized to promulgate and revise standards for the operation of public safety answering points within New York State.

In accordance with Executive Order #3, the Statewide Interoperable and Emergency Communications (SIEC) Board Meeting will be open to the public.
