### Course Description:

*IED Awareness* is designed to provide a comprehensive overview of Improvised Explosive Devices (IED) for law enforcement (LE), fire, and emergency medical services (EMS) to assist in the execution of their duties. The course will cover a brief history of the use of IEDs and their evolution as a terrorist attack weapon. This course will also familiarize first responders with the various types, components, and attack methods of IEDs.

The course includes discussion based scenarios that will guide emergency personnel through the attack cycle in relation to the IED manufacturing process while identifying points of observable activity that can be communicated to emergency responders. Students will also be exposed to a Home-Made Explosive (HME) laboratory in order to facilitate discussion on IED dynamics pertaining to the attack cycle.

- History of IEDs
- IED Components and Manufacturing
- Attack Methods
- HME Laboratory
