Introduction and Background: The primary goal of the NIMS ICS All-Hazards Position Specific Training Courses is to provide all-hazards competencies and behaviors for Command and General Staff and selected Unit Leader personnel who are members of an existing or developing Incident Management Team (IMT). Competencies in the training are focused around the ability of the student to assume specific position responsibilities, lead assigned personnel, communicate effectively, and to ensure the completion of assigned tasks in order to meet identified objectives for the position. Personal qualifications to serve as members of IMT's are designed to consider a combination of training, operational experience during exercises or actual incidents, field mentoring, trainee opportunities and administrative requirements.

Course Description: This course provides an overview of Unit Leader duties and responsibilities, the Planning Section and the planning process, Resources Unit Leader functions including resource tracking systems, operational planning, and resource products/outputs. The Status/Check-in and Demobilization functions are covered to provide students with the knowledge to perform those duties if necessary

Target Audience and Student Selection Criteria: Persons currently or likely to assume the role of a Status/Check-in Recorder or Resources Unit Leader on an Incident Management Team
