Description:

The New York State Disaster Preparedness Commission (DPC) Exercise Coordination Committee is sponsoring a NY Responds (NYR) training course to be held at the State Emergency Operations Center (EOC), Albany, New York. NY Responds is the web-based solution to integrating and managing multiple functions of the State EOC. The system allows Agencies and Counties to follow the status of their resource request as it moves through the State EOC. This training program will introduce users to the NYR environment from log-in to situation reporting, and accessing and using key functions and tools.

Course Curriculum Structure and Topics:

- Multi-Incident Management
- Defining 3 types of information that enter the system
- Resource categories and management
- Roles, Rights and EOC information flow
- Creating & Viewing Calls
- Situation Reports and IAPs
- System-wide functions & tools, Library, Phonebook
- Geo-Coding reports, requests, and offers

Who Should Attend?

The target audience for this course is SOEM employees, DPC Agency Liaisons, County Emergency Managers and personnel who may be assigned to the State Emergency Operations Center (State EOC). SOEM employees need supervisor's approval to attend; county employees must have their county emergency manager's approval.

If you have taken the NY Responds course and are taking this class as a refresher, your previous NY Responds or State Emergency Operations Center Course can be used as the prerequisite.
