

**NEW YORK STATE INTEROPERABLE AND EMERGENCY COMMUNICATION BOARD

Pursuant to Public Officers Law Section 104, the New York State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services' -- Office of Interoperable and Emergency Communications gives notice of a meeting of the State Interoperable and Emergency Communication (SIEC) Board, on Wednesday, November 13, 2013, at 10:00 a.m., in Albany, New York.

The SIEC Board was established under Article 26 and 6A of the Executive and County law, respectively, to review policies and programs intended to improve interoperable and emergency communications for first responders throughout the State and make recommendations to the Commissioner of the Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services. The Board meets quarterly; this is the fourth meeting for 2013.
