This course provides basic instruction on response procedures for terrorist incidents involving energetic materials (explosives and incendiaries). The course includes classroom presentations that address potential terrorist bombing targets in US communities, common military and commercial explosives available to terrorists, improvised explosive devices (IED's) and response procedures that support safe and effective operations during bombing incidents.

At the conclusion of this course **You Will:**

- Prepare emergency responders and others who are involved in incident response to perform safely and effectively during incidents of terrorism involving energetic materials; and
- Instill participants with respect for the destructive potential of energetic materials that may be used by terrorists in a WMD incident.
- Recognize potential explosive and incendiary materials, devices, and device materials and the activities required to maintain personnel safety.
