Description:

This 5.5 hour course is sponsored by the NYS Division of Homeland Security and Emergency services (DHSES) and the Office of Emergency Management.

The refresher course focuses on applying Basic ICS knowledge and refresh basic NIMS principles for students to have a comprehensive understanding in support of larger Incident Types and events. Students will learn essential operational components that prepares them for Emergency Management operations and support. This course is particularly helpful for those who took a basic course more than 5 years ago or intend to take ICS Intermediate (I-300).

Prerequisites:

Basic ICS 200 classroom or FEMA IS 200. Any Independent Study (IS) version.

Cost:

There is no fee for the course. *Transportation* costs are the responsibility of the participant. *Lunch* will be provided by the Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services. *Lodging* for the nights of March 28-29, 2012, will be paid for non-profit, local or state government staff that are commuting more than 50 miles each way from their home or workplace.

*Note: Federal employees and Private Sector employees are **not** eligible for lodging.*

Students requesting accommodation payment must contact your hotel of choice from the [Hotel List](#) and **reserve your own room as a DHSES-SPTC registered student**. You must attend all required course sessions to be eligible for funding. Failure to attend all sessions will result in the registrant being responsible for all expenses incurred.
