OFPC Announces New Initiative



500.1 Authority, intent, purpose and scope

(a) The Department of State, Office of Fire Prevention and Control (OFPC) has authority to inspect the majority of public and independent college facilities in the state for compliance with both the Uniform Fire Prevention and Building Code (UFPBC) and Education Law, section 807. The Department, through OFPC, also has authority to prepare inspection reports, issue citations and corrective orders for violations, take appropriate actions to ensure its orders, and do all other things necessary and appropriate to effectuate the law.
