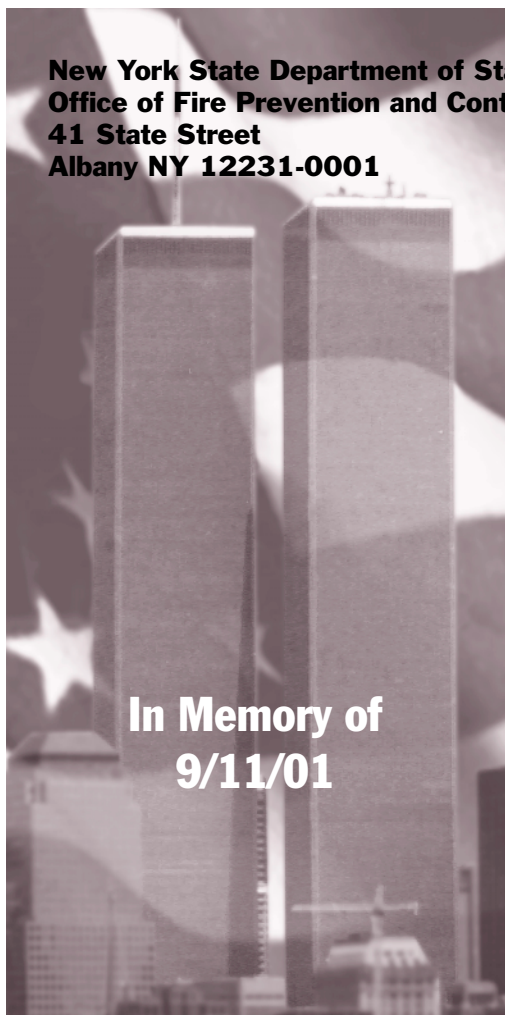

## ABOUT THIS REPORT

This document is an abridged version of the traditional *Fire in New York* report format. The master statewide data table on the next page shows statewide fire data for each county and New York City for 1999, 2000 and 2001. Data for 2000 and 2001 that has been received in both Version 4.1 and Version 5.0 formats has been included in the yearly totals. The fire cause tables at the right reflect Version 4.1 data only. The three-year summary on the last page includes both Version 4.1 and Version 5.0.

## THE DIGITAL TRANSITION

As change sometimes comes slowly, it often brings with it progress. The Office of Fire Prevention and Control (OFPC) is nearing the conclusion of a five-year transition in New York's Fire Reporting system format. What began with a 1987 study group within NFIC (the National Fire Incident Council) is close to becoming a reality: *Version 5.0*, a completely computer-based fire reporting system.

As predicted in *Fire in New York 1998*, approved Version 5.0 software is now available from 51 vendors. Since 2000, a number of fire departments in the state have begun to submit Version 5.0 data on disk or via e-mail to:

For those departments without the ability or desire to use the computerized forms, OFPC has developed and is now pilot-testing new paper forms which are entered into the database via scanners and handwriting-recognition software. Along with the familiar Incident Report and Casualty Report forms, a new Investigation/Juvenile form has been added.

Similarly, the first phase of pilot testing has begun for the data retrieval system. Using the Internet, fire service officials will be able to directly access and query the fire reporting database. Protection is afforded by password-only access and strict control of permitted levels of access. Rather than several months of lag between submitting a report, having it entered and then needing a programmer to generate a report back from the system, data is instantly available as soon as entered — within seconds for digitally-filed reports; within hours of receipt for the machine-scannable paper forms.

By 2003, only one fire reporting database will be utilized. Our goal is to have 1999, 2000, 2001 and 2002 data converted from Version 4.1 and be on-line this year. Every year, the oldest year on file will be archived to make room for the new year. The archived data will be stored on CD for easy research of the archives.

In Autumn of 2002, the new Version 5.0 paper forms will be distributed, at which time Version 4 paper forms will no longer be accepted. Those who report Version 4 data on disk may continue to do so and their data will be converted and entered into the Version 5.0 database.
