Regarding: **Interregional Concurrence Request for Region 55, Window 3**


Dear Mr. Hayling,
Region 55 has completed its Window 3 channel allotments in the 821-824/866-869-MHz public-safety frequency band. In accordance with the provisions in our 800-MHz Plan, we are seeking concurrence for the proposed channel allotments.
