Letter of Intent (LOI) for Planning Grants**

You must use this LOI for all PLANNING GRANT requests to develop or update a multi-jurisdictional hazard mitigation plan (HMP). Previous LOIs may not be considered.

Please review FEMA's *Local Mitigation Planning Handbook* and the *2017 NYS Hazard Mitigation Planning Standards and Guide* (www.dhSES.ny.gov/recovery/mitigation/planning.cfm) for requirements.

Lack of plan, or the expiration date of a current plan, will be a factor in ranking. DHSES encourages applicants to submit LOIs for the update of HMPs that will expire before July 2023. The state will not support funding for plans that evaluate risk to a single community in a county, or to a County's assets without including those of all participating jurisdictions.
