DHSES-OEM STAFF DEVELOPMENT & OPERATIONS TRAINING

Description:

This State EOC-specific course is designed to enable trained EOC staff personnel to operate efficiently during an incident or event within the New York State Emergency Operations Center, utilizing the Incident Command System (ICS). This course focuses on the EOC coordination role, the ICS/EOC relationships, and effective integration of Emergency Support Functions (ESFs).

Course Objectives:

1. Describe how the NIMS Command and Management component is utilized in the State NYS EOC to support the management of expanding incidents.
2. Describe the incident/event management process for EOC staff in an expanding incident as prescribed by this training program
3. Implement the EOC incident management process on a simulated expanding and evolving incident.
4. Develop an Incident Support Plan for this simulated incident.
