The New Mexico Institute of Mining and Technology (New Mexico Tech) will be presenting this course. This program supports these imperatives by providing current training to first responders with the knowledge, skills, and abilities to effectively prevent, interdict, and respond to an imminent threat caused by homemade explosives laboratories and producers.

- Identify Homemade Explosive (HME) precursor materials and manufacturing equipment.
- Identify Improvised Explosive Device (IED) components and manufacturing indicators.
- Recognize Homemade Explosive (HME) laboratory indicators.
- Identify scene safety and security procedures at a Homemade Explosive (HME) incident.
