Description:

The Tornado Awareness course provides emergency managers, first responders, and community members across all sectors with a basic understanding of the latest knowledge in tornado science, forecasting, warning, and preparedness. The course prepares participants to understand the basic principles of tornado science, including geographic distributions, conditions of formation, and typical characteristics, as well as to appreciate the complexities of the tornado forecast process. This allows them to make better-informed decisions when severe weather threatens. The course concludes with a group activity designed to facilitate dialogue about how best to prepare and respond to a tornado scenario, based on an actual event.

Prerequisite:

It is recommended that the participants have a general understanding of the Incident Command System and the National Incident Management System (IS-100, IS-200, IS-700, and IS-800).
