Introduction and Background: This course takes an all hazards approach to Staging Area development and management. The course stresses pro-active planning for, development of and management/maintenance of an All Hazard Staging Area. The course expands on the duties of a Staging Area Manger's role and includes logistical/planning components of a functional staging area as well as the needed qualifications and skill sets a Staging Area Manager should possess.

Description:

This course is designed to provide emergency responders with a robust understanding of the duties, responsibilities, and capabilities of an effective Staging Area Manager.

Target Audience and Student Selection Criteria:

Persons likely to assume the role of the Staging Area Manager or, persons who may be assigned to work in a supporting role in a staging area.
