Core Objectives:

Deliver and sustain a safe and effective response to bombing incidents;
Explain how to apply the lessons learned from the London bombing to help prevent and/or respond to a possible local bombing incident;
Identify and explain the threats posed by terrorists' use of explosives against U.S. domestic targets;
Identify commonly used explosives;
Recognize and identify indicators of an imminent attack;
Recognize bombing injuries and identify appropriate treatment;
Perform patient triage throughout bombing incident response, and engage in exercises involving triage; and
Safely conduct appropriate preventive, preparatory, and response actions during both the pre and post detonation periods of a bombing incident.
