Description:

This course is designed to help participants safely and effectively respond to a biological incident by using an integrated approach. The course provides detailed information about various biological agents and possible methods of dissemination-whether naturally occurring or intentional. Participants will identify appropriate assessment and response actions and will review personal protection, containment measures, and tools that may be accessed during a biological incident

Objectives:

At the end of this course, participants will be able to:

- use a baseline knowledge of concepts and terminology associated with biological incidents
- support the response efforts of all types of biological incidents by selecting appropriate resources for information
- apply knowledge about biological agents and diseases to their response roles during a biological incident
- recognize equipment and processes associated with producing, preparing, and disseminating bioterrorist agents
- select the appropriate response tools and protection measures to safely and effectively respond to a biological incident
- create plans to recover from a biological incident
- effectively support a response to a biological incident
