“SURFACE TRANSPORTATION EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS AND SECURITY- FREIGHT BY RAIL OR HIGHWAY”

This course will train the target audience to recognize and prioritize the importance of facility and conveyance hardening in regards to the specific dangers associated with the transportation of freight. Participants will learn management/planning tools to counter IED operations and evacuations where freight transportation creates the potential for catastrophic events when combined with materials being shipped including hazardous materials. Participants will also be trained to utilize the NIMS/NRF to prioritize organizational immediate actions and response operations. There will be special emphasis on National Special Security Events (NSSE's)

Attendees should be management level personnel representing jurisdictions such as states, counties, or cities, including fire service, law enforcement, emergency medical service, emergency planning, public health, and hazardous materials response

Participants should have some responsibility for the management or security of either facilities or jurisdictions in which freight by rail or highway systems are present. There are no specific course prerequisites; however, participants are strongly encouraged to complete incident management courses IS100, IS200, and IS700 online at www.nimsonline.com before attending this course.
