



PER-220 Emergency Response to Domestic Biological Incidents

Description

This course is designed to help participants safely and effectively respond to a biological incident by using an integrated approach. The course provides detailed information about various biological agents and possible methods of dissemination—whether naturally occurring or intentional. Participants will identify appropriate assessment and response actions and will review personal protection, containment measures, and tools that may be accessed during a biological incident.

Course Objectives:

At the end of this course, participants will be able to:

- Use a baseline knowledge of concepts and terminology associated with biological incidents
- Support the response efforts of all types of biological incidents by selecting appropriate resources for information
- Apply knowledge about biological agents and diseases to their response roles during a biological incident
- Recognize equipment and processes associated with producing, preparing, and disseminating bioterrorist agents
- Select the appropriate response tools and protection measures to safely and effectively respond to a biological incident
- Create plans to recover from a biological incident
- effectively support a response to a biological incident
