

Public Assistance Applicant Briefing Announcement

DR - 4755 Severe Storm and Flooding

Incident Period: September 28, 2023, to September 30, 2023

On January 30th, 2024, the State of New York received a Major Declaration from President Biden for the damages caused by the Severe Storm and Flooding (FEMA-4755-DR) in Kings, Nassau, and Westchester Counties. The declaration authorizes Public Assistance for Categories A through G for eligible applicants. The Applicant Briefing provides an overview of the FEMA Public Assistance program and procedures necessary for eligible entities to apply for participation in DR-4755 and ultimately get reimbursed for eligible expenses. Eligible applicants include State and local governments and certain Private Non-Profit (PNP) organizations. Eligible PNPs may include hospitals, houses of worship and private non-profit schools.

- (a) participate in the disaster as Public Assistance applicants if eligible; and
- (b) submit for reimbursement for FEMA-eligible expenditures incurred as a result of DR-4755.
