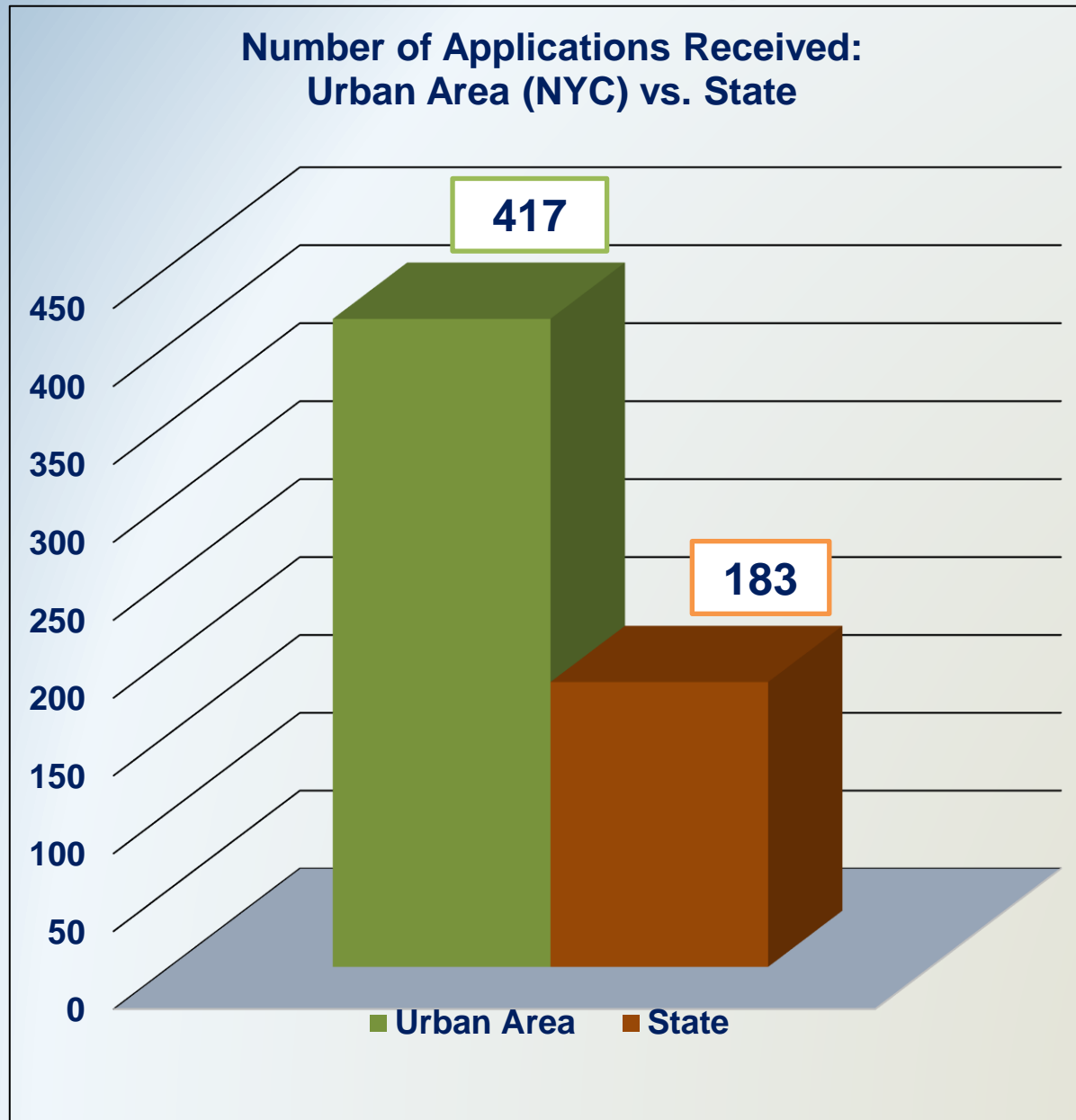

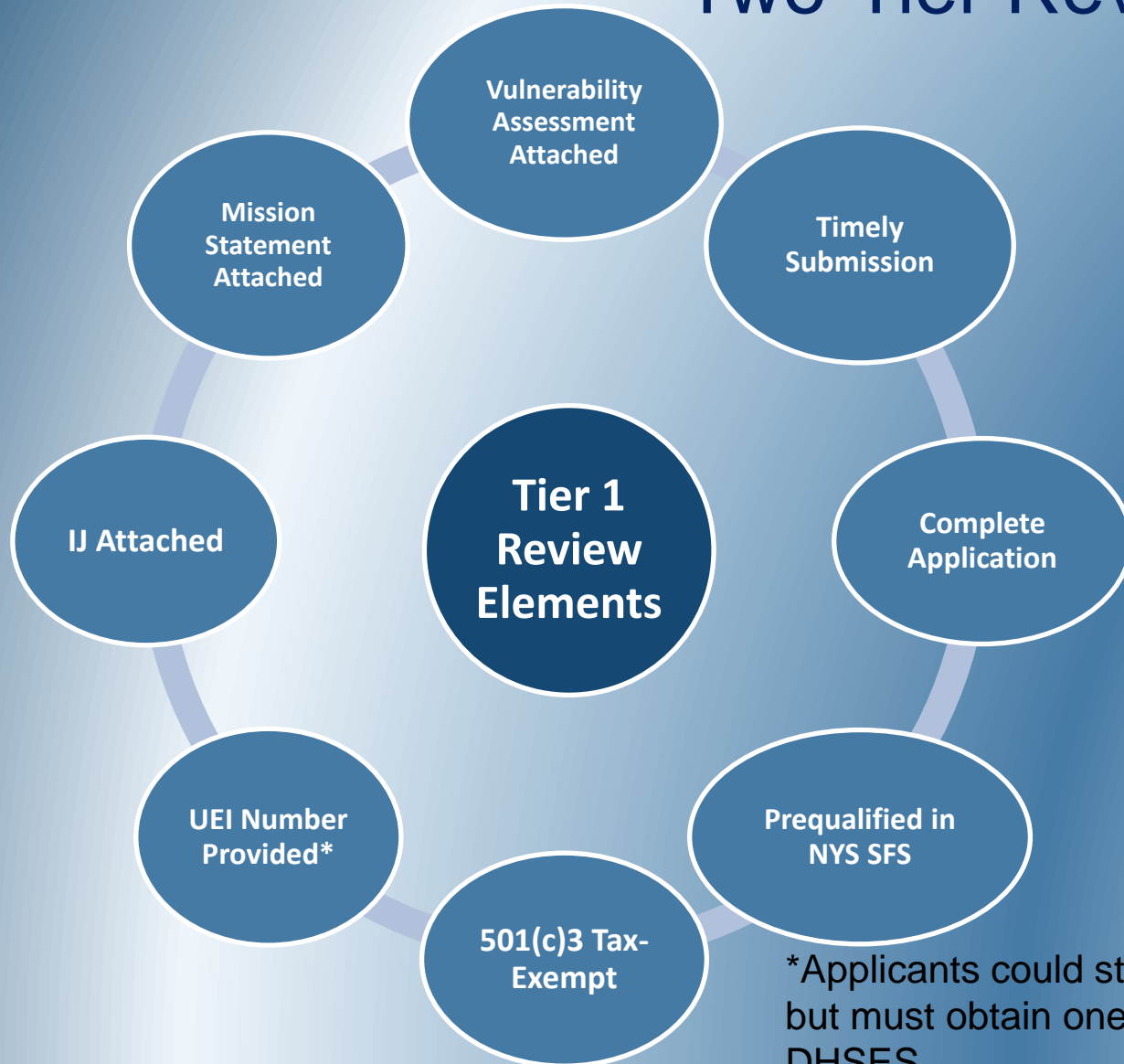

# NSGP Review Process

## Two-Tier Review Process



### Tier 2 Review:

All sections of the Investment Justification are reviewed and scored by either DHSES Staff, the NYC Urban Area Working Group (UAWG) or the New York State Police (NYSP).

\*Applicants could still apply without having a UEI, but must obtain one prior to contracting with DHSES

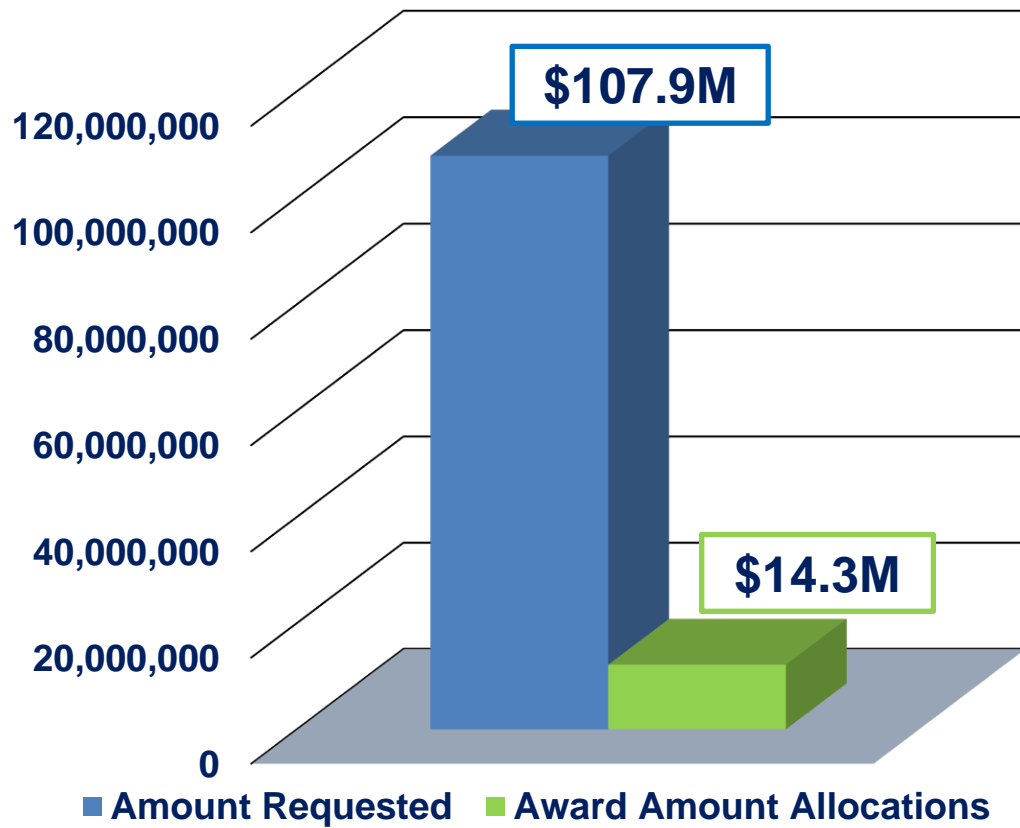
