Course Description:

The course is being delivered jointly by the New York State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services and the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Services. **This course has prerequisites.**

The DCJS SWAT Operator course is specifically designed to train selected law enforcement officers in the Tactics, Techniques and Procedures necessary to resolve special police emergencies which require skill sets above and beyond the capability of a normal police patrol response.

Course Provider:

This course is being taught by a collective team of highly skilled SWAT instructors from various New York State County and City law enforcement agencies including the State Preparedness Training Center and National Center for Security & Preparedness.

Audience:

This course is restricted to officers who have successfully met the course prerequisite requirements as set forth in the New York State DCJS SWAT Operator Course Instructor Guide.

Prerequisites:

Each student **MUST** pass prerequisite testing prior to starting the course. The purpose of the testing is to ensure each student is able to fully engage in the required training. The testing includes:

1. Perspective students must be examined by a medical doctor licensed to practice medicine in the State of New York to ensure they are able to engage in the strenuous physical activities of SWAT training. This includes the ability to engage in strenuous training activities and perform skill demonstrations while wearing individual SWAT equipment including an air purifying respirator.
2. A physical fitness test consisting of a 1 ½ mile run, sit-ups, and pushups scored at the 70th percentile (age and gender normed). This is the same fitness test used in the Basic Course for Police Officers at a higher level of fitness.
3. A handgun shooting evaluation with a minimum score of 90%.
4. Air Purifying Respirator (APR) fit testing pursuant to §27-a of the Labor Law (29 CFR 1910.135).
5. Students who do not submit a completed SWAT Operator Course – Applicant Prerequisite Testing form on or before the first day of the course will not be permitted to remain in the course.

Costs & Lodging:

There is **NO FEE** for this course. Lunch will be provided each day. Travel and all other meals are the responsibility of the course participant.

Lodging will be provided on the nights of Sept 25-29, Oct 2-6, Oct 30-Nov 3, and Nov 6-9, 2016 for public sector personnel only. After your enrollment is confirmed in the course, you will receive an email verifying your lodging needs.

You are only eligible for lodging if your residence and official work station are more than 50 miles from the training center. You must be enrolled in the course and have received lodging confirmation from the SPTC **before** arriving at the Training Center, or your lodging will not be covered and you will not be allowed in the class.
