



Course Description

MGT-466 Sport & Special Event Enhanced Risk Management & Assessment

Description:

This course provides participants with tools and methodologies for conducting venue-specific and event specific risk assessments. In the course, participants will utilize assessment outputs to make risk mitigation decisions and determine how to measure the effectiveness of decision-making. This innovative training will introduce methodologies designed to complement and expand on national critical infrastructure framework guidelines. The interdisciplinary course stresses the importance of leveraging and applying proven practices to a wide range of sport and special event safety and security risks.

Course Objectives:

- Describe foundational risk management principles and concepts for creating a comprehensive risk management strategy.
- Identify and assess event and venue specific risks using the Critical Infrastructure Risk Management Framework.
- Prioritize risks and develop mitigation strategies related to events and venues for enhancing preparedness and protective measures.
- Identify and evaluate the effectiveness of risk mitigation for continuous improvement.
- Identify threats, assess risk, develop mitigation strategies, and discuss continuous improvement opportunities for an event or venue.
