Course Information:

FEMA Region II in partnership with NYS Office of Emergency Management are hosting the following REP course:

PER-316 REP Radiological Accident Assessment Course

This course addresses radiological consequences of accidents involving radiological materials. This includes accidents or incidents involving commercial power reactors, lost sources, dispersion devices, and transportation. The focus of the course is concepts involved in formulating protective action recommendations following a radiological accident, such as dose quantities, atmospheric dispersion, dose projection, protective action guides, and derived intervention levels. Participants engage in problem-solving sessions and a tabletop exercise.

Required Prerequisite:
RAAC (AWR-925-W)

This web-based course is a prerequisite for the resident classroom course PER-316 "Radiological Accident Assessment Concepts (RAAC)." As such, this course provides only an overview of key concepts that will be addressed in more depth in the classroom course.

In this course, you will learn how to assess the offsite radiological consequences to the public following a release of radioactivity from nuclear power reactors and non-reactor incidents, and how to use this assessment as a basis for recommending protective actions to decision makers.

Please note that this course will take approximately 16 hours to complete. It is recommended that you plan on taking the course in multiple sittings.

Cost:

There is no fee for the courses. Lodging and Transportation costs are the responsibility of the student.

Completion:

Participants who actively participate, attend all course hours, and pass a written test, will receive a Certificate of Attendance for the course.
